#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

***NR2.09100*. Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs which have sired two and not more than four dogs entered in the show. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualifications or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed. The owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the Get. The Stud Dog must be entered in another class and entered in the "Stud Dog Class" and must be shown in the ring with his Get.

***NR2.09200*. Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.

**NR2.09300. Brace Class** -Two dogs of the same variety & must have at least one common owner & presented by a maximum of two handlers. - The dogs comprising the Brace MUST be named at the time of the entry. Dog must be entered in another class & entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes - "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, i.e. Brace #1, Brace #2, etc.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Junior meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.
